**MID-YEAR CONTROLLED TESTS:
Friday 11 June 2021 – Friday 25 June 2021**

Attached, please find the mid-year controlled tests timetable for your information.

- The Term 2 extra-murals end on Friday 4 June, to allow students extra time to study for the controlled tests.
- Full and neat uniform is to be worn every day, and excellent behaviour continues to the last day.
- Punctuality is essential. No extra time will be given in the event of late-coming.
- Every student attends every day. Absence from a study session will result in strict penalties.
- Absence from a controlled test will result in no marks given. ONLY a doctor's certificate indicating a SERIOUS ailment will be acceptable, and only after we have investigated its validity telephonically with the doctor. If a student misses a study session without excuse, formal detentions will be issued.
- School closes at 1:00pm during controlled tests. Day scholars must go home immediately after school is released.
- Active study will be undertaken when a student is not actually writing a controlled test.
- Study sessions will be conducted in silence. Any misbehaviour will result in the learner being removed from the venue, and being penalised.
- Cheating will result in no marks being awarded, and an expulsion-level disciplinary enquiry called. Students be warned! If a Matriculant is found cheating, we are obliged to report the incident to the Department of Education, for further disciplinary action.
- Our fees policy remains in effect during the controlled test period. Please do not disrupt your child's education by late payment of fees.
- As controlled tests will be written during the winter, staying warm is an important consideration. Students are encouraged to dress warmly, and may be wrapped in blankets or sit in sleeping bags in the test venues. Non-regulation scarves, gloves and woollen caps may be worn, but only in the controlled test centres.
- A good night's sleep, healthy food, exercise, good lighting and fresh air while studying are essential during this time.
- Students will not be allowed to borrow or lend any stationery or equipment during the controlled tests. No tippex is allowed.
- Cornerstone College's procedures regarding cell-phones and electronic devices hold during controlled tests. The mere presence of cell-phones in controlled test / study venues will result in a controlled test irregularity disciplinary enquiry being called.
- These controlled tests contribute significantly to the final mark, and careful preparation should continue until the final controlled test.
- The last week of Term 2 [28 June – 2 July] will comprise **ESSENTIAL REVISION**, and must be considered as part of the formal controlled test process. Absenteeism, therefore, will not be accepted.
