Please note the following important points:-

1. **School times: 28 June - 2 July**

Please note that we will resume normal school times from Monday 28 June – Thursday 1 July i.e. Foundation Phase leaves at 1:30pm, Intermediate Phase at 1:45pm and High School at 2pm.

On Friday 2 July (last day of Term 2), Foundation Phase will be released at 11:30am, Intermediate Phase at 11:45am and High School at 12 noon. Schooling is COMPULSORY until the last day of term, as very important test revision will be undertaken and we will continue with new curriculum areas.
