- No unmarked stationery will be received but sent back home to be marked as requested.
- Please cover your child's books with paper but **NOT** plastic yet. We will give them cover pages at school and send them home to be covered in plastic.
- Tissues, wet wipes and reams of paper are contributions to the classroom and they will not be returned if the child leaves the school during the year.
- Please ensure that the art supplies fit into the ice-cream container.
- Please don't replace items that can still be used from the previous year. **E.g. art supplies and the lever arch file can still be used in the next year. Only re-cover lever arch file if necessary.**
