- Please cover your child's books with paper but NOT plastic yet. We will give them cover pages at school and send them home to be covered in plastic.
- Tissues, wet wipes and reams of paper are contributions to the classroom, and they will not be returned if the child leaves the school during the year.
- Please ensure that the art supplies fit into the ice-cream container.
- Please don't replace items that can still be used from the previous year. E.g. art supplies and the lever arch file can still be used in the next year. Only re-cover lever arch file if necessary.
- In order to save you money, your child may continue to use the exercise books from the previous year until they are full. Thereafter they will need to be replaced.
