Dear Parents and Guardians

Re: Primary School Sports Day

The Primary School will be holding a Sports Day for all Primary School students and staff on Friday 20 February 2026. Transport will only be provided to and from the school for Hostel students. If you choose for your child not to be involved in the Sports Day, he/she should attend school as usual and he/she will spend the day in compulsory supervised study.

Please collect your child from the sports fields by 12:15pm sharp (excluding the aftercare students whose parents make arrangements with us). **If your child is not collected by 12:15pm, your child will be transported back to the school and a charge of R200 per hour will be incurred to your account to cover the transport and staff overtime costs.**

We invite all parents and grandparents to join us to enjoy the day and to watch your children participate in the sports races. Please bring along camp chairs and umbrellas. There will be food trucks, boerewors rolls and a tuckshop available. As part of our Sports Day, we will be having a short Fun Run for all students and parents to participate in. Please note that there will be a parent and grandparent race during the morning and you are more than welcome to participate. Please also note that no alcohol and/or smoking/vaping will be allowed at the Sports Day. This promises to be a morning full of excitement and enjoyment.
