Monday 25 May 2026 – Friday 19 June 2026

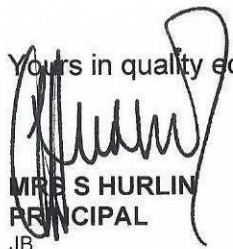
Attached, please find the mid-year examination timetable for your information.

- The Term 2 High School extra-murals end on Friday 22 May, to allow students extra time to study for the mid-year examinations.
- Full and neat uniform is to be worn every day, and excellent behaviour must continue to the last day of school.
- Punctuality is essential. No extra time will be given in the event of late-coming.
- Every student must attend school every day. Absence from a study session will result in strict penalties.
- Absence from an examination will result in no marks given. ONLY a doctor's certificate indicating a SERIOUS ailment will be acceptable, and only after we have investigated its validity telephonically with the doctor. If a student misses a study session without excuse, formal detentions will be issued.
- School closes at 1:45pm during the examination period. Day scholars must go home immediately after school is released.
- Earlier school closing times will be communicated in the school diary on the previous day.
- Diaries must be signed by the parent/guardian each day. Should a student fail to write in the closing times for the next day, or should the diary not be signed, the student will be required to stay at school until 1:45pm on the day concerned. Diaries may not be signed in advance.
- Students are not permitted to loiter around Silverton when they are released from school. Study facilities are available in the Hall after school. Students who are waiting for transport or for siblings from Primary school to be released, must wait in the Hall after school.
- Active, supervised study will be undertaken when a student is not actually writing an examination.
- Study sessions will be conducted in silence. Any misbehaviour will result in the learner being removed from the venue and being penalised.
- Cheating will result in no marks being awarded, and an exclusion-level disciplinary enquiry called. Students be warned!
- Our fees policy remains in effect during the mid-year examination period. Please do not disrupt your child's education by late payment of fees.
- A good night's sleep, healthy food, exercise, good lighting and fresh air while studying are essential during this time. Cell phones and other devices should be put away during exam studies at home.
- Students will not be allowed to borrow or lend any stationery or equipment during the examinations. No Tippex is allowed.
- Cornerstone College's procedures regarding cell-phones and electronic devices hold during the examination period. The mere presence of cell-phones in an exam or study venue will result in an examination irregularity disciplinary enquiry being called. No smart watches may be worn in the study or exam venue.
- These examinations contribute significantly to the final end-of-year mark, and careful preparation should continue until the last exam paper.
- The last week of school (Monday 22 – Friday 26 June) will be set aside for ESSENTIAL revision of the mid-year exam papers and school attendance is compulsory.
