MONDAY 1 JUNE – THURSDAY 18 JUNE 2026

Attached, please find the mid-year examinations timetable for Grades 4 – 7 for your information.

Please take note of the following:

- The Term 2 Primary School extra-murals will end on Thursday 28 May 2026.
- Full and neat uniform is to be worn every day, and excellent behaviour must continue until the last day of exams.
- All students must be on time.
- Attendance is compulsory until the last day of term (Friday 26 June 2026). ONLY a doctor's certificate indicating a SERIOUS ailment will be accepted for absenteeism.
- There must be no talking during examinations and study sessions.
- School diaries must be at school every day.
- Cornerstone College's procedures regarding cell-phones and electronic devices hold during the examination period. The mere presence of cell-phones or devices in the examination venues will result in an examination irregularity disciplinary enquiry being called. No smart watches may be worn in the study or exam venue.
- Students will not be allowed to borrow or lend any stationery so kindly ensure that each student comes to school with all the stationery that will be needed.
- Examination / assessment irregularities or cheating will result in no marks being awarded, and an exclusion-level disciplinary enquiry called.
- Our fees policy remains in effect during the mid-year examination period. Please do not disrupt your child's education by late payment of fees.
- As examinations will be written during the winter, staying warm is an important consideration. Students are encouraged to dress warmly and may be wrapped in blankets in the exam venues.
- A good night's sleep, healthy food, exercise, good lighting and fresh air while studying are essential during this time.
- Students must bring books for the subject they will be writing the following day in order to prepare.
- These examinations contribute significantly to the final end-of-year marks, and careful preparation is required from all students. Please support the learners in preparation for the examinations.
- Grades R - 3 students will also be doing mid-year assessments in class from now until the end of term.
- As from Monday 1 June 2026 until Friday 19 June 2026, all Grades R - 3 students will end school at 12:15 pm and all Grades 4 - 7 students will end school at 12:30 pm.
- The last week of school (Monday 22 June 2026 to Friday 26 June 2026) will be set aside for ESSENTIAL revision of the mid-year exam papers and school attendance is compulsory. Grade R – 3 students will end school at 13:15 and Grades 4 – 7 students will end school at 13:30.
- Pebbles After-Care Centre will be open for the remainder of the term.
- Kindly also note that there will be waiting area during this period (as long as it is necessary). Students are not permitted to loiter around Silverton or wait in transport vehicles when they are released from school.
