Dear Parents / Guardians

We are almost at the end of Term 2 and we would like to thank you for a great term and for your tremendous support towards Week of Bounty, which was a great success. Please take note of the following:



1. Attendance is compulsory until the last day of term.
2. As from Monday 22 June 2026, Grade R to 3 students will end school at 13:15, Grades 4 to 7 students will end school at 13:30 and High School will end school at 13:45. The last week of school will be set aside for ESSENTIAL revision of the mid-year exam papers.
3. All Primary School students will write compulsory cycle tests/assessments on the last two days of this term (Thursday 25 June 2026 and Friday 26 June 2026). All High School students will write compulsory cycle tests on Friday 26 June 2026. These cycle tests/assessments contribute significantly to the final end-of-year marks, and careful preparation is needed. Students will receive zero if these cycle tests/assessments are missed. The teachers will communicate via the diary which subjects will be written.
4. School will close at 11:30am (Foundation Phase), at 11:45am (Intermediate Phase) and at 12 noon (High School) on Friday 26 June 2026 for the holidays. It will also be a Fun Day for both schools and food trucks will be available. More information will follow next week.
5. We will re-open for Term 3 on **Monday 20 July 2026** (a day before public schools), at 07:45am.
6. All boarders need to leave Hostel between 1:30pm and 5:00pm on Friday 26 June 2026 except Matrics who are attending compulsory Winter School. Parents of boarders may not pressurise our staff to release the boarders earlier than 1:30pm.
7. Boarders need to return on Sunday 19 July 2026 between 2:00pm and 5:00pm. The office will be open to receive July boarding fees.
8. Pebbles After-Care Centre and Waiting Area will be open on all school days.
9. A reminder to diarise Saturday 25 July 2026 for our next Parents' meetings. The Primary School meeting will be held from 10:00am to 12 noon. The High School meeting will be held from 1:00pm to 3:00pm.
10. Please note that we will be having a Photo Day on Thursday 23 July 2026 for all Primary and High School students. Kindly ensure that your child is neat and tidy for his/her photo.
